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Plan of Action: A holistic approach to higher education.

1. Enabling Quality Assurance culture in UP's curricular programs
 - a. Promote both internal and external quality assurance to continue academic excellence
 - b. Ensure faculty wellbeing while striving for excellence
 - c. Include more innovative interdisciplinary academic programs (minor programs) that connect the academe and industry (stackable programs and micro-credentials)
2. Increase academic and research partnerships internally within and across CUs for public service aimed at developing competencies and potential of faculty and aligned with their interests or specialization
3. Harmonization of faculty human resource development, including career and leadership training, succession planning, equitable faculty promotions, promoting health and well-being, and increased lifelong learning opportunities (financial literacy, HMOs)
4. Continue building the UP basic education units as incubators for new innovations in teacher education
5. Integration of new technologies in higher education with incorporation of multi-disciplinary collaboration and experiential learning. Increase support for laboratory upgrades of STEM laboratories across the system.
6. Strengthen support academically for creative technologies- generative and digital arts, digital performance art, biotechnology and bioart.
